RPES Jnana Saraswati Public School was established in the year 2013. The school got affiliated to CBSE for MS Level in 2018 and SL level affiliation in 2019.

It is my immense pleasure to present the annual report of RPES Jnana Saraswati Public school which has a total strength of 335 students with 77 new admissions from Nursery to Grade 10 for the academic year 2021-22.

As we all know from the year 2020-21 due to worldwide pandemic, technology is playing a significant role to help in teaching –learning process during school closures. I take pride to share with you all that the online classes in our school went on effectively and we received words of appreciation from the parents. I congratulate all the teaching staff for their innovative efforts. It is our pleasure that the performance of our teachers during this pandemic has contributed positively in adding new admissions.

Academics:

Excellence in academics is the hall mark of a good institution. In that case, RPES Jnana Saraswati Public school is heading towards the higher levels of accomplishments in a very commendable manner by attaining 100% results in Grade 10 CBSE board exams from past 2 years. Online classes for the academic year 2021-22 started from June 3rd onwards and we have successfully completed with one periodic assessment, term-1 exam and PTM virtually.
