Annual Report – 2023-24

The Academic year 2023-24 started with the Orientation programme to enhance Pedagogical knowledge and to strengthen the teaching skills of teachers.

- 1st Orientation programme was held on 29th May, Resource person being Smt. Gurujit Kaur, Oxford advantage for the discussion on NEP.
- 2nd June by Smt.Shylaja Shastry on -Mental Health and Happy Classroom.
- 31st June to 2nd July by Smt.Shylaja Sampath on -The Pedagogy of story telling.
- 1. World environment day was celebrated on 5th June 2023 the sole objective of the Programme was to spread the awareness about the conservation of our environment. To enhance the art of public speaking, elocution competition, was held from Grade-8 to 10 on the Topic—'Solution to plastic pollution' and poster making competition on the Topic—'Beat the plastic pollution' for Grade-5 to 7.
