The school started in the academic year 2013-14 with a blissful inauguration in June 2013 by Sri Sri Sri Nirmalanandanatha Swamiji, Adichuchunagiri Mutt, the chief guest being Sri K.N. Bhat, Principal Kendriya Vidyalaya, IISC Campus, Bangalore.

Our school got affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi for MS Level in 2017, SL level in 2018 and SSL in 2021.

This year is special for us in many ways. In this 10th academic year we are successful in getting 240 new admissions and now we have reached the strength of 500.

It is the time for us to savor the sweetness of success as our school got upgradation up to Senior Secondary level (Grade 12) from CBSE, New Delhi. This year we have started science stream for Grade 11 and we have an academic association with BASE.

The 10th grade students of Academic year 2021-22 have excelled in their board exam performance by bringing laurels to the school by grabbing 100% results.

All these 10 years we have ensured that our objective and our walks are complimentary to each other in order to provide value based and career-oriented education to contribute socially responsible citizens to the society.

Our objective and commitment continues in the coming years also.

The 10th academic year of RPES JSPS started on 5th May,2021, 3 Periodic assessments and half yearly exams have been conducted. This year we have also introduced with the cycle test from grade-1 to 8 in order to scale up the academic progress of our students.

In keeping with the school's policy of continuous up gradation of knowledge and skills, teachers' have attended various orientation programmes organized by CBSE and also capacity building programmes provided by the curriculum provider.

The activities commenced from Nursery wing in various fields like cultural, sports etc..

- RPES JSPS- Nursery wing was reopened on a happy note and welcomed all it's students for the new session 2022-23 on 16th May. Buddha Poornima was also celebrated on the same day with all the positive vibes.
- School has made a sincere attempt to make learning more enjoyable for kinder garten children. We have one day in a month as "No Bag Day". On this day, students are involved to bring out the hidden talents.

- They carry importance in the development of children's cognitive skills. Colours are some of the earlier words they tend to identify and relate. It's important to incorporate them into their daily activities, because children remember colors better than verbal clues. In this regard, colours are introduced to our Kindergarten children to develop cognitive skills and eye contact among the little ones.in the month of June and July.
- Learning shapes helps children identify and organize visual information. Nursery children were introduced with shapes in the month of July.
- Various sports activities and field trips like visit to the Vegetable & fruit market, Visit to park were organized to ignite their curiosity. Festivals like Deepavali ,Krishna Janmashtami, Onam, Navaratri were celebrated in our school to inculcate the culture and tradition.
- Various activities are awaiting for the coming days for the holistic development of the child.
- We whole heartedly thank the parents for trusting RPES Jnana Saraswati Public School and handing over the little tiny tots to mould and refine them.

Now, Moving to the primary and higher primary activities

- To commemorate the birth anniversary, enlightenment and ultimate liberation of "Lord Buddha", Buddha Poornima was celebrated on 16th May by telling the stories about the spiritual leader in the class rooms.
- "<u>Conscious Planet</u>" is a global movement to save Earth's soil from extinction. In this regard, Isha Foundation, led by well-known, Sadhguru, Spiritual leader has launched the "Save Soil Movement". Students from Grade 6 to 10 Participated in the event on 25th May by writing letters to the prime minister.
- To raise the awareness on protection of our environment, Sowing the seeds campaign was organized in the school on 4th June. Children sowed tomato seeds in coconut shell. Only one Earth "Living sustainably in Harmony" with nature was emphasised. Students and teachers took the pledge for saving the environment. Awareness was created among the students to avoid plastic and make our premises as a plastic free zone.
- Mask making is a fun way to boost the creativity. It evokes the sense of appreciation for beauty. Students form Grade 1 to 10 showcased their creative presentation on 11th June. A fabulous participation of all the students was observed during this joyful activity.
- To emphasise the importance and benefits of yoga in life yoga day was celebrated on 21st June. Students actively participated in mass yoga. A speech was delivered about the international yoga day to bring about the awareness of yoga and its benefits.

- 1st July is observed as National Doctor's Day in India to honour the contribution of Doctors and to show them gratitude as they care 24X7 for the whole community. In this regard, students were also trained to give immediate first aid and an activity of preparation of First Aid Kit was organized from Grade 3 to 10.
- World Chocolate Day is celebrated on 7th July every year to commemorate the invention of chocolate. Grade 1 & 2 students wrote short notes on chocolate. Drawing & Colouring competition on chocolate was also conducted. Election canvasing for school election was also done on the same day. Candidates competing for election introduced themselves and made familiar about their symbols.
- Har Ghar Tiranga is a campaign launched by the Government of India under the aegis of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. The Har Ghar Tiranga campaign is an initiative to encourage the citizens of India to bring Tiranga (India National Flag) to their homes. In this regrad, different house wise Competitions were held from Grade 1 to 10 on this topic. On 6th August.

To show the gratitude and love towards the teachers our students celebrated teachers day on 3rd September in the school. Students showed their love by giving the teachers a handmade greeting cards.

Mrs.Ambika explained the concept, rules and regulation of the houses and announced the school house names i.e. Kadamba, Chalukya, Hoysala and Rashtrakuta.
